### CARPOOL

ALL CHILDREN ARE DROPPED OFF BY MEANS OF THE ONE- WAY DRIVE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE DAY.

Please do not walk your child into school at the beginning of the day. We need for everyone to follow the rules beginning with the first day.

Please fill out your carpool form and return it to the CDLC office ASAP. At the end of the first day we will check in with each car to see who is being picked up and give you a carpool number. Be sure to keep this number in your car so that it is available each time you need it. If you need additional carpool numbers just let us know.

The Burnsville Police have asked us not to block traffic with the carpool line that extends out onto Fairview Drive. Please follow the diagram and traffic patterns found in your Parent Handbook.

### TUITION

Just a reminder - the next tuition payment is due on September 15th. You will be paying for the month of October. Remember you are always paying a month ahead. Please send the tuition check attached to the outside of the school bag, so that it is visible immediately. We do not look inside the school bags on a regular basis so you need to be sure that we can see the check when you send it.

### LABEL, LABEL, LABEL

Please be sure to label any correspondence with your child's name, teacher and the session that your child attends. Also be sure to put your child's name in the memo line of your tuition check to ensure proper credit to your child's account. Lastly, please remember to label all clothing, coats, hats, backpacks, etc worn by your child.

### RABBIT AND GUINEA PIG

The rabbit and guinea pig will be at school beginning on September 13. The first date for taking home a pet is September 17. We have had so many children who want to take home an animal that we will be asking families to only sign up for one or the other once.

## Celebrating Children LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch is an extended day program (11:30 AM - 3:15 PM) offered during the school year.

The program includes supervised lunch (bag lunch provided by parents); rest period, stories, games, art and music.

Registration: Families may contract for one or more days per week for the year or register on a drop in basis depending on space available.

Tuition: \$25 per day (payment due on the date of service)

Pick-up: All Lunch Bunch participants must be picked up at the back door unless they contract for the full year.

Cancellation Policy: 24 hours notice is required to receive a full refund.

If school is closed on a day your child is registered for Lunch Bunch due to inclement weather no refund will be given for the first 5 days missed. Commencing with the sixth day and thereafter, tuition will be refunded for each missed day.
