LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch is an extended day program (11:30 AM - 3:15 PM) currently being offered Wednesdays and Thursdays. The program includes supervised lunch (bag lunch provided by parents); rest period, stories, games, art and music.

Registration: Families may contract for one per week for the year or register on a drop in basis depending on space available.

Tuition: \$25 per day (payment due on the date of service)

Pick-up: All Lunch Bunch participants must be picked up at the back door unless they contract for the full year.

Cancellation Policy: 24 hours notice is required to receive a full refund.
