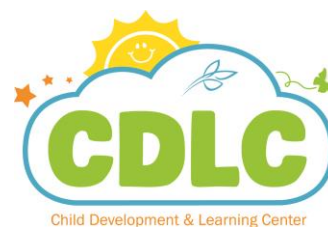

Crock Pot Apple Sauce

1. Peel, core and slice the apple.
