

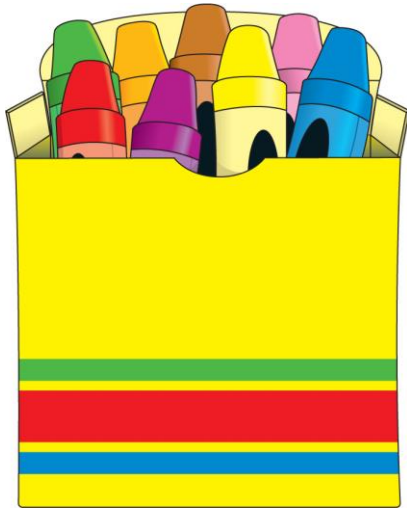

### Feed My Starving Children South Metro Meal Pack

This year marks our 10th annual Feed My Starving Children mobile pack season. Over that time we have hosted events onsite and more recently we have joined the South Metro Meal Pack event, made up of 23 different churches from 9 denominations, serving together to feed kids around the world. To date, Prince of Peace has been a part of packing 15,950,000 meals and part of a volunteer tally of 64,400.

This year's event will take place February 6-11 at the former Rainbow Foods in Apple Valley. The event goal is to pack 4,000,000 meals and raise \$880,000 to cover the cost of the food. The Prince of Peace portion of that "grocery bill" will be \$125,000.
