

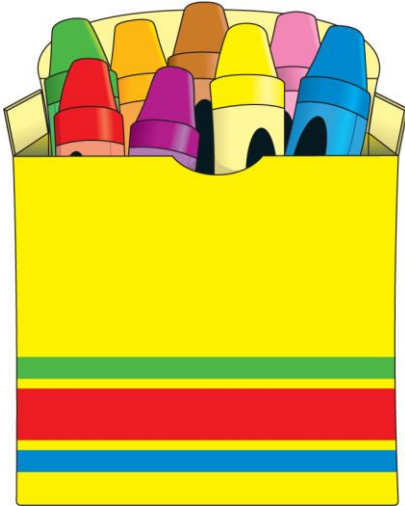

This year, the basket themes are:
