SCHOOL CLOSINGS

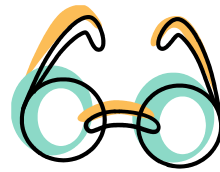
If severe weather causes school closings or late starts for ISD 191

If the symptoms occur, parents will be notified to pick up their child from school. We have an area where the child may rest until his parent or other authorized person can pick him up.
