FALL CONFERENCES

& SCHOLASTIC BOOKFAIR

Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held on October 21st & 22nd. **There will be no school for children these days!** The conferences will be 15 minutes long and give parents an opportunity to see how the first few weeks of school have gone for their child. You will be sent a link to sign up for conference with your child's teacher on Sign-up Genius. Please sign up as soon as possible. Childcare will be provided in the church nursery for a donation of \$1.00 per child. Please plan on arriving a few minutes early to check your child in and still are on time for your conference.

CARPOOL

- At drop off please be sure to have your child ready to get out of the car, car seat unbuckled, backpack ready and last hug and kiss given, when it is your turn. This will ensure the line moves smoothly and in a timely manner.
- Your child's car seat should be on the passenger side of the vehicle, so they do not have to move between cars to get to the sidewalk.
- Do not get out of your car. Let the staff and volunteers on carpool duty get your child out of the car. This is what they are there for.
- **DO NOT PULL OUT AND AROUND CARS IN FRONT OF YOU IN THE CARPOOL LINE!** Please be patient! We are moving as quickly as possible and will get even quicker as everyone learns the process.
- Please do your best to be on time for both drop off and pick up! When you are late for drop off your child misses out on opening music and Christian education. As for when you are late at pick up time, your child must wait and may become anxious that they have been forgotten.

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VOLUNTEER
